

The Band Boosters met on November 8, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. in the band room. Booster Vice-President Tena Bryan brought the meeting to order.

Tena began by sending volunteer sign-up sheets around for Butter Braid/Candle delivery and fruit unloading and delivery.

Standing reports were addressed. The secretary report was asked for. Teresa Crotts made a motion that we dispense of the reading of the minutes since they are available on the Internet. Sherrie Hudson seconded the motion. Upon no further discussion, the motion passed unanimously.

The treasurer's report was then called for. Debbie Zanot gave the Nov. report. Wanda Milby made a motion that we accept the treasurer's report, and Teresa Crotts seconded the motion. After no further discussion, the motion passed.

We then moved on to old business.

Band pictures will be taken Thurs. after the Veterans Day Parade. Group and individual pictures require separate forms.

Butter Braid/Candle orders will arrive Mon. around noon. The candles are here and being sorted. They will be distributed on Nov. 15th. Orders will be handed out after school.

We then moved on to New Business:

The Veteran's Day Parade will take place in Covington at 10:00 on Nov. 11th. Students will depart at 8:30 from the school. They will be fed pizza at Cobb Parr Park around

11:30. Students need to bring a change of clothes. Volunteers are needed to bring coolers and deliver pizza to the park. Pictures will be taken after they return.

Movie night will be Dec. 3rd from 7:00 – 10:00. Once they come into the building, they are not to leave until someone comes to pick them up or until the movie is over.

The Christmas Parade will take place on Dec. 4th. Students will meet at the River of Life Church, probably around 3:30. Students will take uniforms home afterward and have them cleaned.

Fill the Sleigh will take place on Dec. 3rd at 11:00. Each student should bring a new, unopened toy that is **not** wrapped.

The Christmas concert will take place at MHS on Dec. 9th. MMS will hold their concert on Dec. 14th. The concert date is the last day to turn in fruit money. The attire will be ALL black. The choir is pre-selling tickets. They will keep that money for their program. All ticket sales at the door will go to the band boosters.

Last year we supported a family for the holidays. Mr. Trobaugh said that he would get more information on this project.

The auction/dinner fundraiser will take place in the spring. We need a chairman and a committee for this fundraiser. The date will be set at a later date.

Questions:

John Crotts asked if the new trailer could be used to transport the uniforms. Mr. Trobaugh said that it would take too long to get the uniforms out and would delay the students in getting ready for competitions.

Mr. Trobaugh then addressed the group. He thanked the parents for going to help with the state trip and doing such a good job with supervision.

He then listed several things that made this year extra challenging. 1) There was a new visual design. He did not write the drill this year. 2) This is the largest band he has had in his 17 years at Munford. 3) There were 65 new members in the band. Mr. Trobaugh said that with all of these challenges, he was very pleased with the final program.
