Secretary report was called for and a motion was made and passed to dispense of the reading since the secretary was not present.

Donna Cherry presented the Treasurers' report. A motion was made to accept the report as read and the motion was passed.

John Crotts read the proposed change to the bylaws concerning the Hydration Standing Committee.

A discussion commenced over the National Champions shirts with the corrections. The question was if we replace all of the student's shirts at a discount of \$7 a shirt. Christy Wilson made a motion that we do not replace all the students' shirts being that the students whose names were misspelled or left off have already received new shirts. Sheri Hudson seconded the motion. One person opposed and one abstained from voting and the motion passed.

A discussion commenced over the wording in the proposed bylaw change. The concern was that the line "support on-site medical personnel as requested by the Band Director" might be an area of liability and should be removed. Christy Wilson made a motion that the proposed change be sent back to the ad hoc committee for revision. Tom Norwood seconded the motion.

The man who made the National T-shirts wants to make yard signs with the same artwork. Discussion commenced about the quality and price of the signs and it was decided to table the issue until January when we would have more information.

Mr. Trobaugh addressed the group:

Mr. Trobaugh discussed National Championship rings. The rings will be ordered on January 18th and arrive in April. The total cost of the ring is \$260 with a \$60 deposit being due the day they are ordered. Mr. Trobaugh desires that every student get a ring.

National and show patches were handed out and extras are available for sale for \$5 each.

Fill the sleigh was wonderful and the toys will go to Tipton Cares.

He requests that we purchase license plates to sell at the spirit table with the Munford Band "M" and 2011 National Champions clearly visible.

As a Thank You the Boosters will make shadow boxes with a picture of the entire band and patches to be presented to Munford High School, The City of Munford, The Town of Atoka, The Tipton County School Board, and Tipton County. John Crotts was made the shadowbox committee chair, and a budget of \$2000 was proposed by Christy Wilson and seconded by Kathy Reid, the motion passed.

He discussed the Firehouse opening, requiring students to be there not before 2:00 or after 2:30.

Christy Wilson reminded us that uniforms must be returned by Jan. 6th in dry cleaning plastic. Cross belts and braids must be washed as well, washing instructions are available online.
