

The Band Boosters met on August 8, 2011 in the band room. Booster President Heather Topping brought the meeting to order.

Standing Reports were addressed. The secretary report was asked for and a motion was made by Tina Owen to dispense of the reading because the report is available online. The motion was seconded and passed.

The treasures report was read by Donna Cherry. A motion was made by Sheri Hudson to accept the report as read, Stephanie Van Der Linden seconded and the motion was passed.

We then moved to old business.

The floor was then opened for questions.

The possibility of adding the Gatorade preparer as an executive position was addressed. Heather expressed that the by-laws do not list that as an executive position but if there is to be a proposed change to the bylaws it has to be done so in writing and presented at the next booster meeting.

A budget for vehicle patience was discussed. Donna Cherry proposed we allocate \$2500 for the vehicle maintenance fund. The motion was seconded by Jeanie Davis, and the motion passed.

Heather Topping introduced Mr. Trobaugh for his remarks.

He addressed the practice schedule and expressed that the schedule would return to normal as soon as weather permits. He also expressed that it is necessary that students complete homework before practice. If your students grades cannot be seen on parent connect please contact him.

He expressed that parents are invited to practice anytime, especially freshman parents.

Our first ballgame is in two weeks and students should have their new music memorized by Friday.
