Standing reports were addressed. The secretary report was asked for and a motion was made by Sherry Hudson to dispense of the reading because the minutes are available online. Kathy Reid seconded the motion and the motion was passed.

The treasures report was called for next and was presented by Brenda Norwood. Chris Hacker made a motion to accept the report as read and Jeff Mckelva seconded the motion. The motion was passed.

We then moved on to old business.

Please make sure that your student has all uniform components including white shorts. Heather asked for a volunteer to take coolers to Dyer Co. and Denise Dillon volunteered.

Magazine fundraiser is currently underway, and is due on September 19th.

The AC fundraiser is still ongoing. \$40 for a heating and air inspection, all proceeds go to Munford Band Nationals account.

If you filled out the paperwork for a background check the price is \$48, you will be contacted by the board of education to schedule an appointment.

The competition schedule has been posted on the website. Someone asked about Wednesday practices because they are not on the calendar.

Celebrate rehearsal is at 10:30 at FUMC, the band will perform at noon in blowout attire. If you are working celebrate you will still be able to see the band perform.

Practice under the lights and pictures are scheduled for Oct. 7th. Students will stay after school for pictures and then practice from 6 - 8, boosters will provide pizza. Payment for pictures is due when picture is taken.

Yard signs are available for order until September 15th, \$20 per sign, instrument or name are additional \$2.50 each.

A proposition was made by Lynda Johnson to make "Gatorade mom" an executive position according to the by-laws. A motion was made by Jeff McKelva and seconded by Candy Wildes. Discussion commenced. By-laws were read addressing the understanding of what an executive position is and clarification was made that the proposition is to make the "Gatorade mom" a standing committee. After continued discussion the first motion was rescinded and Debbie Zanot made a motion to add Gatorade to the bylaws as a standing committee, the motion was seconded by Chris Hacker, and the motion passed. An Ad-hoc bylaws committee was formed, and Debbie Zanot was made chair by President Heather Topping.

A question was asked about the decision to change how snacks and drinks for competitions are collected. In the past students brought \$5 and a 12-pack of drinks to cover snacks and drinks for competitions. This year students were asked to bring \$20 per family. Heather Topping explained that the change was made because of our lack of storage due to the concession stand accident.

Another question was asked about the amount of time it is taking checks to be deposited in the bank. Debbie Zanot gave the explanation that several people have to record the payment and when the treasurer receives it she then has to record it and this process takes time to make sure it is done correctly. Being that we changed officers this year the process will speed up with time and practice.

There was a question as to the status of the foundation for the concession stand. The last update Heather had was that they were supposed to start pouring it 3 weeks ago.

Someone asked what the budget for Nationals was and an answer of \$90,000 was given, we have approximately \$8000 in a designated account.

A question was asked about the arrival time for the morning shift at Celebrate and Heather answered that first shift should arrive at 6am.

There were no director's remarks because Mr. Trobaugh was unable to attend.

A motion was made to adjourn and was seconded by Jamie Miller and passed. The Munford Band Boosters will meet again on Monday October 10th.
