She said that the boosters would have to discuss and vote on the matter. After some discussion, Wanda Milby made a motion that we spend the \$35,000 to send the band to state competition. Christy Wilson seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Jennifer announced that we now have a second equipment trailer. The decals are currently being put on.

On Friday, Oct 15th, there will be a mini-band camp. There will not be a football game that night. The band will travel to Center Hill on Oct. 8th to perform at the football game.

The next meeting will be Oct. 4th due to fall break.

As far as the background checks go, they cannot be done until Debbie cuts a check for them.
