

The Band Boosters met on June 13, 2011 in the choir room. Previous Booster President Jennifer Turner introduced the new President Heather Topping and the meeting was brought to order.

Heather Topping introduced the new officers, committee chairman and announced open committee positions.

The Secretary's Report was called for and Jennifer Turner made a motion that we dispense with the reading since the minutes are available on the Band website. Jamie Miller seconded the motion and without any further discussion the motion was passed.

Treasurer's report was postponed until later in the meeting when Debbie Zanot would be available to present the report with the new Treasurer Donna Cherry.

Concert CD's are available for purchase.

Existing Booster membership expires in July. To be a voting member of the Munford Band Boosters a \$5 per person membership fee is required.

The status of the concession stand was discussed, as well as a backup plan for band blowout.

Volunteers are need for the July 4<sup>th</sup> Concession Stand. Two shifts 1 p.m. - 5 p.m. and 5 p.m. - 9 p.m.

Munford Celebrate is September 17<sup>th</sup>. Boosters have 2 side by side booths reserved. The possibility of a 3<sup>rd</sup> booth by the car show was discussed. It was decided to reserve the 3<sup>rd</sup> booth in order to sell drinks and the possibility of food with the necessary volunteers.

Jennifer Turner presented a fundraising opportunity at AutoZone Park on July 23<sup>rd</sup>. Two shifts would be required, one from 11 a.m. - 3p.m., the other from 4p.m. - 10p.m. 10 volunteers are needed for the afternoon and 30 for the evening. Students 15 and over may participate but 1/3 of the total volunteers must be adults. Profits from the fundraiser would be \$1400. A motion was made by Tina Owen to participate in this fundraiser. Sonja Howard seconded the motion and without further discussion the motion was passed.

Discussed Sonic Fundraising cards, which could be purchased for \$0.25 each and sold for \$5. A motion was made by Jamie Edmondson to purchase 400 cards. The motion was seconded by James Latham and without further discussion the motion was passed.

Lucianne Schoffner read aloud the changes to the by-laws in relation to the allocation of funds for new uniforms. This was the second reading. One more reading is required before the adoption of the by-law change. Tina Owen made a motion to accept the changes as read, Jamie Miller seconded the motion and with no further discussion the motion was passed.

Dana Ecker, President of Munford Touchdown Club was in attendance to present the football programs which will be available for purchase at football games and offer the option to buy space in the program to dedicate to band students. Deadline for full payment and artwork is July

The Treasures report was presented by Debbie Zanot and Donna Cherry.

A motion was made by Tom Norwood to accept the report as presented and was seconded by Stephanie Van Der Linden. With no further discussion the motion was passed.

Sponsorship t-shirts were discussed as a way to thank platinum sponsors. T-shirts would have 2011 show artwork on front and sponsors listed on back. Each platinum sponsor would receive one shirt. A motion was made by Mark Morris that \$300 be allotted for the purchase of sponsorship t-shirts. The motion was seconded by Jamie Miller and without further discussion the motion passed.

Mark Morris brought up the need for a new stand for the practice field. The current stand has been repaired as much as possible and is no longer safe. James Latham made a motion that we allocate \$2300 for a new stand. Jamie Miller seconded the motion and with no further discussion the motion was passed.

Steve Martin the writer of the 2011-2012 show would like to visit; his only request is traveling expenses. Tom Norwood made a motion that \$500 be allotted for Mr. Martin's traveling expenses. Jamie Miller seconded the motion and without further discussion the motion was passed.

This year's budget was discussed. Mark Morris requested \$2000 for the practice field maintenance. Teresa Crotts made a motion to accept that amount and Kathy Reid seconded the motion, without further discussion the motion passed. \$20,000 was requested for Band Camp and \$22,000 for Adjunct Staff. Tom Norwood made a motion to accept that amount and Debbie Zanot seconded the motion and with no further discussion the motion was passed. It was suggested that \$3500 be allocated for Color Guard uniforms and flags and \$750 for operating expenses. Jamie Miller made a motion to accept that amount. A discussion commenced about the cost of new uniforms and flags. Since no one present knew the exact amount required Debbie Zanot recommended that \$5000 be allocated for Color Guard uniforms and flags. Tom Norwood made a motion to accept that amount and Jamie Miller seconded the motion. The motion was passed. \$1500 was requested for Uniform maintenance and operating expenses. Emmitt Topping made a motion to accept that amount and Stephanie Van Der Linden seconded the motion, without further discussion the motion was passed.

Mr. Trobaugh addressed the group. He thanked everyone for their presence and encouraged upcoming freshman parents to get involved. He addressed the issue of Band Blowout and expressed his hopes that the field would be finished in time but if not other dates would have to

be explored.

The next meeting will be held on July 11<sup>th</sup>.

Emmitt Topping made a motion to adjourn and Jamie Miller seconded the motion.
