

The Munford High School Band Boosters meet on January 9th, 2012. Heather Topping brought the meeting to order.

The secretary's report was called for and Tabitha Latham made a motion that we dispense of the reading since minutes are available on the website, Stephanie Van Der Linden seconded the motion and it passed.

The Treasures report was called for next and was read by Donna Cherry. Christy Wilson made a motion that the report be accepted as read and Sonja Howard seconded the motion and it passed.

Teresa Crofts was up next to discuss the shadow boxes. Friends framing has made 24" x 26" shadow boxes for approximately \$125 each. Someone asked the question about where they would be placed, Teresa answered: The band room, front of school, Munford City Hall, Town of Atoka Boardroom, Board of Education, and Jeff Huffman's office in courthouse.

Spirit items for Nationals have been ordered and may be available as early as next week. Kroger cards are still doing well. We earned a total of \$523 in December. Top three earners were Dakota Kutz, Shea Owen and Trent Moyer.

National's rings will be ordered on January 18th, a \$60 deposit will be due at that time remainder of payments will be made with Herff Jones, not through band boosters.

There will be a JT's night on January 23rd, it will be a special night, and an email should go out with details by the end of the week.

The treasurer position has become available do to the fact that Donna Cherry has had to step down. According to The Munford High School Band Booster Bylaws the treasures position can only be held by an active member of the boosters, active member being defined as parents or legal guardians of active Band students with up-to-date dues. Being that Donna is no longer an active member she can no longer hold the position as treasurer. The floor was open for nominations, and Tina Owen was nominated. Stephanie Van Der Linden made the motion that Tina be instated as the treasure for the remainder of the term, until June. Donna Cherry seconded the motion and the motion passed.

The annual Bowl-a-thon will be held on February 11th. Mark Morris is coordinating the event. The cost is \$7.50 a person and take place from 2pm to 4pm. Pledge forms will be sent home. 100% of the money raised by each student will go directly into each students account.

Winter concert will be on February 16th.

A motion was made by Christy Wilson that we purchase the ad and Sonja Howard seconded and the motion passed.

He also requested that we do the same in the state magazine but that we still has some time before a decision had to be made.
