

The Band Boosters met on August 9, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. in the band room. Booster President Jennifer Turner brought the meeting to order.

Standing reports were addressed. The secretary report was asked for. Wanda Milby made a motion that we dispense of the reading of the minutes since they are available on the Internet. Tena Bryan seconded the motion. Upon no further discussion, the motion passed unanimously.

The treasurer's report was then called for. Debbie Zanot reported that we currently have a balance of \$104,393. An explanation of allotted money was given.

Wanda Milby made a motion that we accept the treasurer's report as read. Christy Wilson seconded the motion. Upon no further discussion, the motion passed unanimously.

We then moved on to old business.

Kroger cards are available for \$5. Contact Janet Stevens if you would like to purchase one. The Band Boosters get 5% of all money put on these cards.

The football boosters are not having a program this year. Ads will not be available for purchase after all.

If you can help with Gatorade, contact Christy Wilson. Gatorade must be available to the band members during their school rehearsals and after school rehearsals.

More show shirts have been ordered. If you would like one before the first football game, contact Andrea Sanders at marketing@munfordband.com . Old show shirts are available for \$5. These will be on sale Sept. 10 at the first football game.

Munford Celebrate will be held September 18th. We will host a food booth and a souvenir booth. We will need lots of volunteers. People will be needed to set up, work the tables, cook funnel cakes, and clean up. We will not be attending a competition that day.

Uniform hemming needs to be done by Aug. 17th. Tina Grandberry will hem the work pants for \$5 and the stripes for \$8. Color guard has 2 pair of pants. It will cost \$5 per pair to hem.

Make sure band students wear crew socks with their uniforms. No skin should be showing beneath the uniform pants.

Debbie Zanot addressed fees. Make sure you are getting those paid on time.

Fundraisers – cookbooks will be our first fundraiser. Recipe forms will be sent home soon. We will sell them for \$10 each. We will make a profit of \$7.50 per cookbook.

Coupon books – We will sell the coupon books for \$15. When purchasing a new coupon book, the person will receive an old coupon book for free. This is a 50/50 split. Beverly Johnson proposed that we have a cash incentive for the fundraiser. Mark said that last year, the students received one book free for every eight that they sold, up to 2 free books. Also, for every 5 books that they sold, their names were entered into a drawing. Woody Kinchen made a motion that incentives be \$25 per drawing and the number of incentives be determined by the total sales. Christy Wilson seconded the motion. The motion carried.

We then moved on to New Business:

The school board is now requiring background checks on people who are regularly with the students at school and those traveling with them. These cost \$75 per person. We have about 20 people who will need to do this. It will cost about \$1,500. When asked if this was a one-time thing, Jennifer said that she wasn't sure. A parent who has had a background check done said that it is good for 1 year if you are not working, but as long as you are active with the county, it will remain good.

John Crotts made a motion that we allot \$2,000 for background checks. Wanda Milby seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Drinks and snack money will be collected before the game on Sept. 10. Each student should bring \$5 **and** either one 12-pack of name brand sodas OR one case of water (24 or larger). The money is used to purchase snacks for the students to eat on the buses during competition season.

New spirit items will be on sale at the football games. Check them out.

Jennifer informed the group that the truck is in need of repairs. It is estimated that it will take \$500 to fix. Wanda Milby made a motion that we allot \$500 for truck repairs. Jamie Miller seconded the motion. Upon no other discussion, the motion was passed.

Wanda Milby requested 6 new sabers for the color guard. Sherry Howard made a motion that we purchase sabers, not to exceed \$850. Lucy Allen seconded the motion. Upon a vote, the motion carried.

Teresa Crotts gave a report on the bleacher covers. Jennifer said the booster club approved purchase of covers at a previous meeting. Teresa will proceed with ordering.

John Crotts introduced himself and thanked everyone who helped with the July 4th celebration in Munford. He asked for people to sign up to help in the concession stand with him. He reminded all funnel cake workers that they needed to wear long pants and closed shoes – no sandals.

A parent asked if the band would have pictures made this year. Jennifer said yes, and that she was already working on setting up a date with LifeTouch.

Mr. Trobaugh then addressed the group. He thanked all parents for helping with band camp.
